

RULES FOR CHRISTMAS PARADE
DECEMBER 2, 2011 – TIME: 6 PM
LINE-UP 4:30 PM

1. Dawson Heath is **in charge** of line-up along with his staff.
2. Only drop off a person on Harkness or George Tate Drive after the line-up starts. (Harkness to High School will be blocked)
3. Route – From High School on Harkness to R on Hwy 36, L (Oak St) R (Second St) R on Mulberry to My Zion Church (bus will transport back to high school if walking) to George Tate Dr. to point of beginning.
4. Lights will be necessary since it is a night time parade. All entries must be properly illuminated. No candles, Torches or luminaries. If your entry has music, it must be seasonal holiday music. You may advertise on your entry but **you cannot throw ANY OBJECT INCLUDING CANDY** from your entry.
5. Commercial Floats are available to rent from Kip Dingler Floats. These floats are completely decorated with Lights but no sign. You furnish your own sign. The hitch used is a pin. If you are interested in renting a commercial float, please come by the Chamber to see the sketches available.
6. Participants in the parade are prohibited from wearing a Santa Suit! We have ONE Santa from the North Pole.
7. Any participant in the parade demonstrating inappropriate behavior will be escorted from the parade by Jackson Police Department or Butts Co. Sheriff's Office. For information, please call Butts County Chamber of Commerce at 770-775-4839 – If there is a football game, the route will be changed.
